



POOL AND SPA RULES

The Pool and Spa facilities are for the enjoyment of the Stonegate residents and their guests. The Community Association reserves the right to schedule the pool for special events and classes. Posted rules must be followed. All city and county ordinances also apply.

- Residents are required to carry Association issued Photo ID when using the Recreational Amenities.
- There is no lifeguard on duty.
- Smoking is prohibited in all recreational areas.
- Children 11 years of age and younger must be directly supervised by a parent or responsible adult (18 years of age or older).
- Adult supervision shall be required for groups of more than six under the age of eighteen years old in the Pool/Recreation area.
- After 8 PM, residents under 18 may have only one guest in the pool/spa area.
- Residents are permitted to have 8 guests in the Pool Recreational Area without notifying the Community Association. Exceptions are granted when a resident contracts with the Association for rental of the Community Center, patio or mini-ramada(s).
- Swimwear must be worn in the pool or spa. (No cut-offs.) Infants must wear diapers with rubber pants when in the water.
- No food or beverage may be consumed in the pool or spa. The Ramada areas should be utilized for eating.
- No glass. Drinks must be in non-breakable containers.
- All trash must be placed in trash receptacles.
- No diving or horseplay is permitted. No high-pressure water gun toys, rafts with oars, or unreasonably large rafts, inner tubes or tires will be allowed. No offensive or discourteous behavior will be tolerated.
- No bikes, scooters, rollerblades, skates, skateboards or similar devices are allowed within the recreational areas.
- No pets are allowed within the recreational areas.
- Children under the age of five years are not allowed in the spa (due to health and safety concerns).
- Toys, air mattresses and other flotation devices are not permitted in the spa. The spa is for therapeutic use only.

- Swimming instructors must pre-register with the Stonegate Community Association. They must also provide proof of insurance and the name of the resident they are instructing. Instruction may not be given to non-residents.
- Residents are required to surrender their recreational access keys upon request by any Community Association representative.
- Preventing access gate closure is prohibited. No amplified music permitted in recreational areas.
- Keep out of the fountains.
